A 5% discount is offered for full payment of school fees by Friday 26th February, 2021.

Please note there is no discount on levies, stationery, camps or excursions.

School fees and levies are billed and issued on a monthly basis (from February to November) by email with payment due 14 days from date of invoice. The Year 4, 5 and 6 Camp and some excursions are at an additional cost. Parents will receive an Excursion Permission Slip Email with the details of the excursion/camp including any costs from the teacher prior to the event.

Payment Options

- Direct Debit is a preferred method of payment and forms are available from the School Office or the Parent Portal. Payments can be deducted weekly, fortnightly or monthly and spread over the school year (February to November) or full year (January to December).
- BPAY is another preferred method of payment. BPAY details are on your fee statement.

- If you receive a Centrelink payment, another option for paying your school fees is Centrepay. Centrepay is a bill paying service, free for Centrelink customers, through which deductions can be made from a customer's payment directly to Christ the King Catholic Primary School. Forms are available from the School Office or Parent Portal.
- BPOINT link details are included on the email sent to families each month with their fee statement. Use this link to pay your school fees by credit card.
- Eftpos and cash payments are accepted at the School Office. A receipt will be issued.

Dear Parents

This letter is to inform you of the school fees and levies applicable for the 2021 school year and other important information. Many factors are considered in setting the fees and levies for the school including expenditure from previous years, realistic expenditure for the future, areas in need of maintenance and renewal throughout the school property and our loans for the new school buildings.

Brisbane Catholic Education (BCE) meets the cost of all Teacher, Teacher Aide & Secretarial salaries within the Schedule of Staffing (Schools pay for staffing allocations over and above this schedule), and also provides services, programs & resources for schools. The sources of BCE's funding are Commonwealth & State grants supplemented by a levy on each systemic school (Archdiocesan Education Levy) based on the number of school families.

School Fees for 2021 are:

- 1 child - \$2290.00 per year
- 2 children - \$2990.00 per year
- 3 children - \$3515.00 per year
- 4 children or more \$3865.00 per year

School Fees include:

- Tuition Fees – Tuition fees fund the recurrent expenditure of the school including electricity, telephone, insurance, council charges, cleaning, security. It also includes wages for the employment of 'above schedule staff' such as our groundsman.
- Archdiocesan Education Levy - The Archdiocesan Education Levy is a charge on schools which is sent to the central administration of Brisbane Catholic Education.
- Capital Levy - A Capital levy of \$530.00 per family is included in your school fees
 - The capital levy is used to pay loans relating to our program of capital works undertaken to date
 - It helps maintain our existing facility
 - Please note this is not tax deductible
- Excursions – Depending on the excursion selected by the classroom teacher, some may have a small charge. Parents will receive an Excursion Permission Slip Email with the details of the excursion including any costs from the teacher prior to the excursion.
- Swimming Lessons – (part to be supplemented by families)
- Arts Council Visits
- General School Resources
- CCI Accident Student Insurance

Levies:

Resource Levy

- \$80 per student - This levy supports the purchase, maintenance and replacement of educational resources and reference material. This includes items such as reading books, sporting equipment, science equipment and music equipment. This levy is billed monthly with school fees.

Technology Levy

- \$150 per student – Prep to Year 5
- \$100 per student - Year 6

This levy supports the Christ the King Technology Plan 2021 – 2024 and is billed monthly with school fees.



Stationery

Bookpack

- \$100.00 per student – Prep to Year 6.
- This covers all stationery requirements and is billed with school fees in February.

Student Diary

- \$8 per student - Year 4.
- The student diary is billed with school fees in February.

Camps

Year 4, 5 and Year 6 students will attend camp in 2021. The exact charge for this will not be known until next year but the Year 4 Camp will be approximately \$160, the Year 5 Camp will be approximately \$230.00 and the Year 6 camp will be approximately \$330. The camp fee will be added to your school fees. There will be no concession given on the camp fee.

Accounts

School fee statements are issued by email no later than the seventh day of the month from February to November, and are due for payment fourteen days from the statement date if paying by EFTPOS, BPAY, cash or cheque. If paying by Direct Debit or Centrepay, fees may be paid on a weekly, fortnightly or monthly basis. Accounts are to be finalised by the end of Term 4 each year.

Office Details

The office is open during term time from 8am to 3.30pm. The office is closed during school holidays and public holidays. Please note the office will be open the week before school starts from the 18th January, 2021. For general enquiries please contact Kim, our School Secretary. For any finance related enquiries, including appointments to see the Principal regarding concessions please contact Sarah, our Finance Officer.

Discount – Paying in advance

A discount of 5% applies if the full yearly amount of school fees is paid on or before Friday 26th February, 2021. Please note that the discount applies to school fees only. It does not apply to the resource levy, technology levy, student diary and camps.

Library Fund Donations

The Library Fund Donation is a voluntary donation and not a levy. It is 100% tax deductible and a separate receipt is available at the end of the financial year for tax purposes. Funds are used to buy extra resources for the Library. Donations are very much appreciated.

Building Fund Donations

The Building Fund Donation is a voluntary donation and not a levy. It is 100% tax deductible and a separate receipt is available at the end of the financial year for tax purposes.

Concessions

Should you find yourself unable to pay school fees by the due date please contact the School Principal via the Finance Officer to confidentially discuss how the school can assist you. In cases of genuine hardship the school will consider offering a concession. Concession applications are accepted at the beginning of each year or when the hardship within the family occurs. Concessions are not ongoing and cannot be used to clear previous debt.

In our endeavour to keep fees and levies as reasonable as possible, we rely on the wholehearted support of each family in paying your fees promptly upon receipt of your account, by the due date indicated on your statement. Please note that, as a condition of enrolment, families agree to pay the fees charged.

In conclusion, I wish to acknowledge your financial support of the school in 2020. It is our intention, as it has always been, that we keep the amount payable by parents as low as possible whilst providing quality educational opportunities and facilities for your children.
